What is a Virtual Tutoring Platform?

- Online conferencing system that facilitates tutoring
- Ex. Zoom, Microsoft Teams, BigBlueButton, GoBoard









Why Use a Virtual Tutoring Platform?

- Tutors can help students regardless of their physical location
- Safe, cost-effective option
- Easier to scale
- Wider pool of qualified tutors
- Help students in more regions
- Create easier access to individualized learning

How Do I Choose a Virtual Tutoring Platform for My Program?

Platform Capabilities: What core capabilities does your platform need to have? How will students access sessions?

- Live video conferencing
- Live text chat with direct messaging
- Collaborative digital whiteboard
- Two-way screen-sharing
- Real-time document collaboration
- Recording
- Asynchronous delivery
- Accessibility
- Role-based access controls





How Do I Choose a Virtual Tutoring Platform for My Program? (Cont.)

Platform Considerations: How can I choose the best platform from among the fully-functional options?

- How much specialized training will tutors and students need to use all the platform's useful features?
- Is the software's interface intuitive for both students and tutors to navigate?
- Will infrastructure limitations (such as slow internet connections or old devices) prevent students from using the software at school or at home?



How Do I Facilitate Effective Virtual Sessions as a Tutor?

Tutor Preparation

- Use your best tech
- Know your platform
- Be engaging
- Get there early and stay on-task
- Keep the time



How Do I Facilitate Effective Virtual Sessions as a Tutor? (Cont.)

Student Preparation

- Get to square one
- Stick to a schedule
- Set norms early
- Keep interfaces consistent
- Show, don't tell
- Step by step



How Do I Facilitate Effective Virtual Sessions as a Tutor? (Cont.)

Presenting Content

- Practice makes perfect
- Create structure
- Outline your game plan
- Make your thinking visible
- Mix up the medium
- Present multimedia yourself
- Provide additional resources



How Do I Facilitate Effective Virtual Sessions as a Tutor? (Cont.)

Interactive Content

- Wait for it
- Student voices first
- Multiple methods
- Check for understanding
- Don't just talk
- Watch them work
- Give specific feedback
- Make progress visible
- Purposeful pairing
