Out-of-School Time - Tutoring Program Profile

As part of the Accelerating Scholars initiative, Metro Nashville Public Schools offers tutoring during the day and in out-of-school time. Their OST tutoring program serves approximately 2,000 students at 86 schools annually.



HISTORY OF PROGRAM

Metro Nashville Public Schools piloted a high-impact tutoring program beginning in the spring of 2021. Based on the results of that pilot, the district has grown their high-impact tutoring program to serve approximately 4,000 annually. During the 2022-23 school year, about 50% of students receiving high-impact tutoring were receiving services outside of the traditional school day.



TUTORING PROGRAM MODEL

Metro Nashville Public Schools has scaled their program by diversifying their model to continue offering more options to students. Tutors may tutor in-person or virtually. Each school has a tutor lead to oversee the program in their building. Tutor leads are typically instructional coaches or deans. School support staff typically serve as tutors in the after school model. The district is also beginning to contract with external providers to further expand and scale their high-impact tutoring initiative.





Unique elements for each program. Metro Nashville Public Schools has dedicated curricular resources for content area and grade level band for tutoring.

- Early literacy tutors use the Tennessee
 Foundational Skills Curriculum Supplement
 Resources aligned with their curriculum.
- 3-5 literacy tutors use the CKLA curricular resources.
- 6-8 literacy tutors use the Newsela resources aligned to the My Perspectives curriculum.
- Math tutors use the Tennessee tutoring curriculum, Zearn, and Math by Example/Algebra by Example materials.
